Reveals Field Club Help Provide Home-Town Hospitality!



The Valley Royals have been invited to serve at the **Canadian Cross-Country Championsl Clearbrook Park on Saturday, November 30, 2019.** The club will provide food services for the *Volunteers and Officials* working at this national-level meet happening right here in **Abbotsford!** This is a great opportunity to see the top cross-country athletes in the nation compete and show our home-town hospitality to the people putting on this event.

We have been asked to make and deliver Chili and Buns to the Officials & Volunteers for lunch as well as some snacks and beverages throughout the day. Including feeding our own club volunteers, we are preparing for approximately 100 people. **How can you help?** We need a **Food Service Team** to work together to cover these simple but important tasks:

- Shoppers to find the best deals on chili ingredients, buns, snacks, tea bags & instant cider packages disposable utensils & single-serving containers for hot chili (Submit receipts for reimbursement)
- Drivers/Vehicles to transport Royals Gear: tents, tables, blue table cloths, wagons, plastic Save-On Bags for food delivery, Valley Royals Banners/Signage, Valley Royals water bottles & any food/snacks being stored in the Valley Royals shed loft to the club's hospitality tent in Clearbrook Park. Help with set-up (*The same is needed in reverse afterward—even if you can only help for one of these trips you & your vehicle are needed*)
- Hot Beverages Driver/Vehicle to deliver 300 cups/lids and 3-types of hot beverages: 100 servings each of Hot Chocolate, Coffee & Hot Water (for tea and cider options) in big "Cambro" insulated serving containers and return them afterward (Debbie will place the order and pay for it ahead of time—only pick up & return needed)
- Samosa Delivery Driver/Vehicle (Debbie will place the order and pay for it ahead of time—only pick up & return needed)
- "Warming House" a home in Abbotsford where hot chili in crock pots can be delivered and plugged in on morning of November 30th and where the Lunch Prep Team can meet to prep the buns and package hot chili in single-serving containers & deliver hot in club's insulated coolers/"warmers" to Clearbrook Park
- Cooks to make the chili ahead of time at their homes (including one vegan/vegetarian version and one mildly seasoned version) and deliver it hot in crock pots to the "warming house" on the morning of November 30th
- Lunch Prep & Serve Team to meet at the Warming House to cut & butter buns and package the chili into single-serving containers (labeling vegetarian and mild versions) and deliver the containers hot in Valley Royals insulated coolers being used as "warmers" to Clearbrook Park for lunch time distribution. Also, to help with lunch distribution to officials & volunteers
- Hospitality Team at Clearbrook Park to deliver snacks/beverages to the volunteers and officials as they are working throughout the day and to help lunch prep team deliver the hot lunch
